Noted: For 4K30hz, Input and Output is better to use 5m HDMI cable.

HOW TO USE KEYBOARD HOT KEYS:

Under the condition that the input and output are all connected normally, press the Ctrl button twice in a row to enter the control state, and complete the function control within 10 seconds (otherwise, exit the control state).

The KVM switcher can perform related actions through the hotkeys of the keyboard

Front Panel




1) Indicator light: POWER & IN 1,2

Note: The red and green dual-color indicator indicates the status of the input port. The green light indicates the input HDMI connection, and the red light indicates the USB Type B cable connect to the computer.

- 2) Select Button to switch Inputs
- 3) USB 2.0 and keyboard and mouse input ports

Back Panel




- 1) Inputs: 2x HDMI & 2x USB Type B
- *Power can be supplied by the USB Type B port
- 2) HDMI output port
- 3) DC/5V Power input

Connecting and Operating

- (1) Connect all the PCs to the HDMI KVM switch, then start all the PCs.
- (2) After all the PCs are started in step 1, then you can switch to any PC by keyboard hot key or the key pad on the KVM panel. (For example, if you want to control the PC connected to HDMI IN 2 just press the key under the PORT 2 LED indicator, or the keyboard hot key commands described following).
